Dear All,

The CWG-Stewardship has released its second draft proposal today. Last day for comments is 20th May. The proposed institutional arrangement has changed significantly from the first proposal (external Contract Co model). The new proposal is being fashioned as an "internal model with legal separation" hoping to reach compromise with those participants who wanted to see the stewardship perpetually reside in ICANN. However, even in the new proposal a new legal entity has been proposed. In this, IANA is proposed to be legally separated from ICANN into a new wholly owned subsidiary called PTI. The new IANA Functions Contract will be between ICANN and PTI.
