Dear Anders,

Sorry for the late reply.

Lemon Healthcare, the applicant and I have been discussing the reasonable explanation for your questions. (because medical system in Korea differs from those in other countries)

Q) Does the app also enable virtual doctor consultations (not just making a doctor's visit reservation)?

A) The government has temporarily allowed non-contact online treatment due to COVID-19.

Lemon Healthcare is providing e-prescription service where people can send e-prescription to pharmacies with patient app.

Moreover, the non-contact online treatment will be launched in the near future since Lemon Healthcare is currently developing the service with partners.

Also, doctors can check patients' treatment history anywhere using Lemoncare Plus. With Lemoncare and Lemoncare Plus app, the mobile medical treatment is possible.

Q) Does the service include medical document portability between doctors and clinics (one-step access to patient medical records)?

A) According to the law in Korea, all electronic medical documents must be printed physically when hospitals share treatment history.

For that reason, patients are required to bring their printed medical documents so that doctors can refer to prior treatment history.

The treatment history of each patient is recorded separately at the clinic or hospitals where they used to visit. However, the mobile healthcare platform of Lemon Healthcare shows all treatment history in a single app no matter which clinic or hospital one used to go.

(We provide an environment where patients can easily use hospitals. We provide a platform for patients not for hospitals.)
